

EC-PC ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

The Elizabeth City-Pasquotank County Economic Development Commission was established in May 1976 to provide the basic resources needed to develop facilities and programs essential to promote economic growth within Pasquotank County and the City of Elizabeth City. It is comprised of 20 members (nine voting and 11 non-voting). Voting members: three County Commissioners, three City Councilors and three non-elected members from general population (nominated by EC-PC EDC) with one being the chairman of Committee of 100. Non-voting, ex-officio members are: Chamber of Commerce President, two commanding officers of US Coast Guard Base, Mayor of Elizabeth City, Chairman of County Commissioners, representative of NC Northeast Partnership Board, College of the Albemarle President, ECSU Chancellor, ECDI Director, CVB Director and EC-PC Public Schools Superintendent. Terms are for two years. Generally meets on the 3rd Wednesday at 8:00 a.m. in the Community Room of the Pasquotank County Public Safety Building.
