Bobbi White gave the board updates on Old Business.

Fun Junktion (Trillium) Playground- Grand opening will be held on Sunday, November 20th at 2:00pm at Fun Junktion for the \$650,000 playground.

Coast Guard Park-The second round of bids have come in and are \$200,000+ over budget. This project has been put on hold until grant funds can be secured; possibly winter/spring since this is the funding cycles for CAMA, BIG, and PARTF. The City has installed the park lights and wired the building for electricity.

Bobbi White then addressed new business as follows.

The Parks and Recreation Department's 2016 Christmas Parade will be held on Saturday, December 3rd at 5:30pm with the rain date being December 4th at the same time. Bobbi advised the board that the route may change due to the Road Street closure.

Damages during Hurricane Matthew to the Parks and Recreation's parks and facility were given to the Board.

The annual Boat Parade will be held Friday, December 2nd at 7pm after the last Art Walk.

Youth Recreation surveys that were dispersed to the middle and high schools have been reviewed and the results will be presented to Council.

There were no further comments from the board.
