



PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE CITY OF ELIZABETH CITY COUNCIL

The citizens of the City of Elizabeth City are hereby informed that the City intends to apply to the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality for a funding amendment to two Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Infrastructure awards received in 2022 (19-I-3648 and 21-I-4004). In an effort to involve the citizens of the City and obtain their comments, the City Council will hold a public hearing on Monday, May 12, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. in the Elizabeth City Council Chambers, 306 E. Colonial Ave., Elizabeth City, NC 27909. The purpose of the public hearing is to explain the City's proposed application for amended funding and to allow the citizens of the City an opportunity to express their views concerning the project. This project will include the replacement of approximately 1,658 linear feet of deteriorated water and sewer lines on Ray Street. The City is requesting an increase of \$109,143.37 in award 19-I-3648 and \$7,687.79 in award 21-I-4004 with no change in project scope.

The City of Elizabeth City does not discriminate based on race, color, religion, sex, national origin, handicap, age, or political affiliation in the admission, access to, treatment or employment in CDBG program and activities.
