

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
RELATIVE TO APPLICATION  
BY THE CITY OF ELIZABETH CITY  
FOR FUNDING UNDER THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY  
DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1974, AS AMENDED

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Elizabeth City will conduct a public hearing on Monday, August 14, 2017 at 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the agenda will allow, in the City Council Chambers of the Municipal Administration Building, located at 306 East Colonial Avenue, Elizabeth City, NC 27909 relative to the intention of the City of Elizabeth City to apply for FY2017 CDBG funding under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act.

The City of Elizabeth City intends to submit an application for a grant of approximately \$903,581 in CDBG Infrastructure funds to replace the City's Raw Water Transmission Main between Wellfield Road and the end of the Phase 1 Raw Water Transmission Main at Knobbs Creek.

The following is a tentative list of proposed activities and an estimated budget. The final application will be reviewed at the public hearing.
