PARKS AND RECREATION / SENIOR CENTER:

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

This week, Deputy Chief James Avens was appointed by the North Carolina Law Enforcement Executives Association (NCLEA) to serve on a committee as part of a joint-effort to ensure that all North Carolina law enforcement agencies are in compliance with Department of Justice guidelines that allow for federal funding. This effort was initiated by the NCLEA Program and is supported by the NC Training and Standards Commission staff after being awarded a grant from the Governor's Crime Commission to fund a temporary position for the NCLEA Program.
